# Reminder: The Book Fair is today & Friday!

We look forward to seeing you for our first in-person book fair since 2019! We are partnering with Phinney Books who will stock the fair with an array of books for every grade level. Students will have a

chance to visit the fair with their classroom during one of the two days, plus you can shop after school each day and we will have the book fair open during Friday's family dance. 25% of the proceeds from the book fair will be given to Loyal Heights in the form of credit to stock the school library and classrooms with new books. You can also buy "Teacher Bucks" to give to your student's teacher so they can buy books for their classroom. Cash and credit card accepted.

You Can Shop Virtually, Too! Can't make it in person? No problem! From April 27 - May 11, we'll also have our virtual book fair open through Phinney Books. Here's how it works:

Visit <u>HERE</u> to shop from age-appropriate book lists, plus ANY other books in print available through Bookshop.org—all purchases are counted towards the 25% credit that is returned to the school. Books ordered online will be shipped directly to your home—there is no option for in-store pick-up.

You can also shop at Phinney Books (7405 Greenwood Ave N.) during this time to earn school credit. Just let them know you are part of the Loyal Heights community at check-out.

hosting a concession stand with light snacks and treats. This is their last push to fundraise for Camp Orkila, let's help them reach their goal!




#### **Earth Day Clean-Up Success!**

**Returning volunteers:** If you plan to volunteer in any capacity during the 2022-2023 school year, please make sure that your Volunteer Application is approved and up to date before you start volunteering.

**New volunteers:** All volunteers must complete a Volunteer Application Form online which includes completing an online training video (Adult Sexual Misconduct Prevention Safety), and background check. Instructions for updating and completing Volunteer Applications can be found here.

Please Note: Mr. Steve receives Volunteer Status Updates from the district once a week on Wednesdays. Please make sure that your applications are completed/updated at least 2 weeks before you plan on volunteering. Updates and applications created after Tuesday evenings will not be reviewed until the following Wednesday.
